Description

The conference will bring a group of speakers together to discuss and debate the question: What can we do to design, plan, develop and lobby now and in the immediate future, to help counter the effects of climate change on London's built environment?

Why you should attend?

By 2020 temperatures in Britain are predicted to have risen 1° (and by 2080 up to 6°) due to global climate change, but in central London night-time temperatures can already be over 6° higher than in adjacent rural areas. In combination this may deprive London and its buildings of any natural diurnal cooling capacity as heat island effects begin to last for longer periods.

The aim is to highlight and debate how London should respond to rising temperatures and what role architects, planners and other built environment professionals must play.

What you will learn

How we as architects and construction professionals tackle the issues arising from climate change will depend on a mix of Government policy, innovation and skills. At this conference you will learn from a range of speakers the impact climate change will have on London's built environment and what you can do to mitigate its effects.
